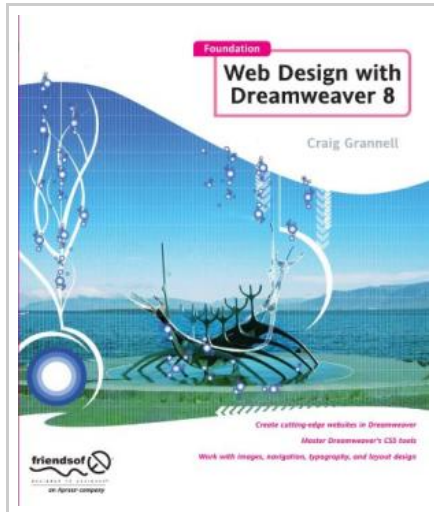




Foundation Web Design with Dreamweaver 8
