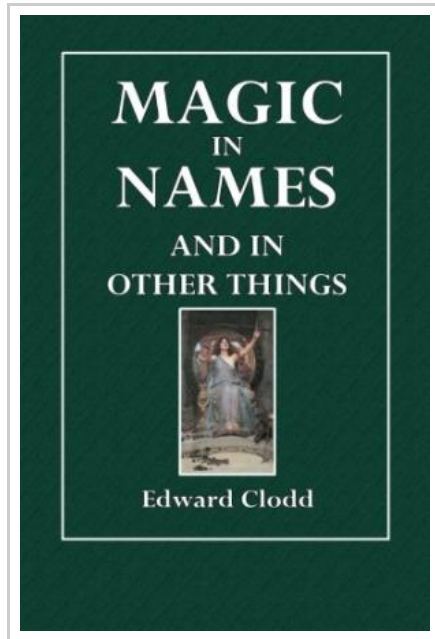




Magic in Names and in Other Things (Paperback)
