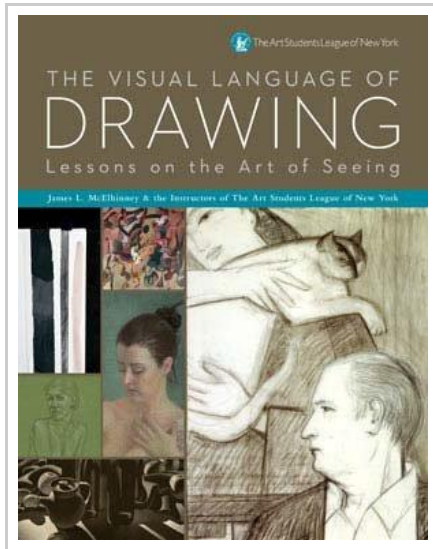




The Visual Language of Drawing: Lessons on the Art of Seeing
