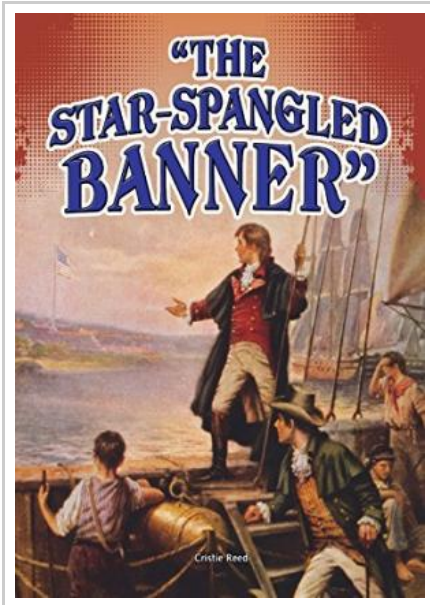




The Star Spangled Banner (Paperback)
