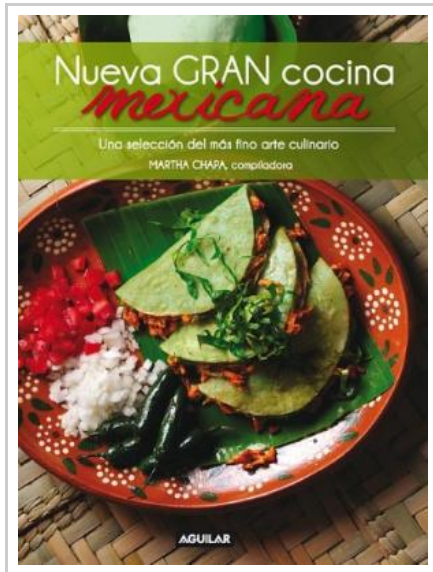




Nueva Gran Cocina Mexicana: Una Selecccion del Mas Fino Arte Culinario
