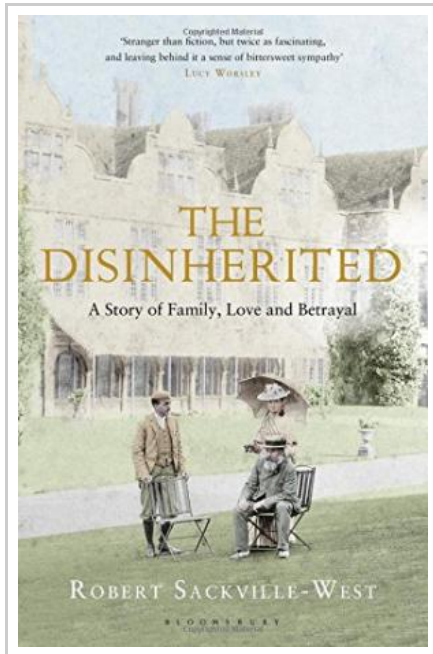




The Disinherited: A Story of Family, Love and Betrayal (Hardback)
